Sub: Verification of e-Way Bill issued by dealers of Mizoram
State-regarding

Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Aizwal (Mizoram)

In his letter dated 19.7.2012, Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Aizwal (Mizoram) has informed that the department has enabled the dealers to download e-Way bills for transport of goods from one place to another. With this arrangement, mentioning of e-way bill number generated from the system is sufficient for movement of goods from the state of Mizoram. The authenticity of such e-Way bills could be verified from the website www.zotax.nic.in by using the option 'Verify e-Way bill'(copy enclosed).

You may bring this to the notice of all enforcement officers in your division while checking transport of goods originating from the State of Mizoram. Officers may note that in so far as receipt of specified goods by a dealer of Karnataka is concerned, the requirements of carrying of e-sugam number in terms of notification no ADCOM (I&C)/ P.A/CR-31/2011-12 dated 23.12.2011 read with corrigendum of even number dated 27.12.2011 has to be enforced even if the consignment is supported by e-way bill number issued by a dealer of Mizoram or not.

Subject : Introduction of paperless e-Way Bill System.

Sir,

I would like to inform you that Taxation Department has been implementing the project for computerisation of Tax Administration in Mizoram in line with the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). In our endeavor to bring "Anywhere anytime" service to the citizens, the Department introduced **paperless e-Waybill System** through online. Mobile SMS service has also been integrated with this e-Way Bill system.

Under the new process, the registered dealer has to generate e-way bill online through the Department's website www.zotax.nic.in, receive e-Way bill details through SMS and inform the e-Way bill number at Taxation Check Gate for verification. The dealer does no longer require printing of e-Way bill as only e-Way bill number is sufficient for verification at the Check Gate.

The genuineness of e-way bill can be verified by anyone from "Verify e-Way Bill" option in the Department's Website www.zotax.nic.in.
